Minutes of the meeting held on 8th June, 2022 under the chairmanship of Secretary (P) with Chief Secretaries and Secretaries (GAD/Training) of all States on Mission Karmayogi

A virtual meeting was held on 8th June, 2022 at 4:30 pm under the Chairmanship of Secretary (P) with Chief Secretaries and Secretaries in charge (GAD/Training) of all States on National Programme for Civil Services Capacity Building (NPCSCB) - Mission Karmayogi.

2. Secretary (P) welcomed all the participants and gave an introduction on Mission Karmayogi.
3. A short brief on Mission Karmayogi was also given by Additional Secretary (DoPT) focusing on the broad ideas in order to achieve the objectives of Mission Karmayogi.
4. A brief presentation on Mission Karmayogi was made by Director (IGOT-I), DoPT. This contained background and objective of Mission Karmayogi along with its institutional structure and present status of implementation.
5. A presentation on Mission Karmayogi was also given by Capacity Building Commission (CBC). Chairman, CBC emphasised on why such initiative is required and how this could contribute to capacity building of civil servants working with the Central government as well as State governments. Secretary, CBC, Member (Admin), CBC and Member (HR), CBC further elaborated on the initiatives taken and case studies conducted by CBC.
6. The States were requested to give suggestions and inputs to enrich the ambitious scheme NPCSCB- Mission Karmayogi and were also requested to be an active partner in this so that the main objective to democratize the learning and training of civil servants could be truly achieved.
7. The suggestions/inputs/queries raised by states are as below:
 - i. It was requested to designate a nodal officer to whom states can connect for furthering their involvement in Mission Karmayogi. For this, CBC will share the statewise list of nodal officers.
 - ii. States requested to include cutting level staff viz. gram sevak, anganbadi staffs etc. for training under Mission Karmayogi.
 - iii. States also requested to on board their respective State ATIs on Karmayogi digital platform and to share content framework/guidelines for creating training modules. Based on shared guidelines states can create and approve their own content.
 - iv. States like Andhra Pradesh had conducted online training and created modules for faceless self-assessment for certain group of trainees. Such exercise can be analysed by Mission Karmayogi team to incorporate its best practices.
 - v. Some states raised queries on how to onboard courses and convert existing modules to e-modules for onboarding on Karmayogi platform. For onboarding, credentials for each state can be created.
8. Meeting ended with vote of thanks.
