Sir,

Kindly refer to the letter No.DPO/BLA/PYT/1804-06 dated 09.11.2012 from District Panchayat Officer, Baramulla. The matter has been examined and also discussed with the Hon'ble Minister, Rural Development & Panchayati Raj in presence of Secretary to Government, Department of Law, Justice & Parliamentary Affairs. The resignations tendered by the Panchs and Sarpanchs after two of their colleagues in Pattan and Wagura Blocks were killed by the militants, have, in fact, been tendered under duress and, therefore, cannot be deemed as resignations. Therefore, the DPO Baramulla should be asked to take further action accordingly.
