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Subject: - Minutes of the Meeting held on 08/07/2017 under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister for Rural Development & Panchayati Raj, Law and Justice Departments J&K at Directorate of Rural Dev., Lalmandi Srinagar.

A meeting to review the progress under flagship programmes viz. MGNREGA, IAY/ PMAY-G etc. was held on 08.07.2017 at Directorate of Rural Dev. Kashmir Srinagar under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister for Rural Development & Panchayati Raj, Law and Justice Departments J&K where in Commissioner/Secretary Rural Dev. Deptt., Director Rural Sanitation, Director Panchayats, Mission Director SRLM, SE (REW) Kashmir, ACDs, DPOs, Executive Engineers (REW) and BDOs also participated. The Director Rural Dev. Kashmir extended warm welcome to the chair including all other participants and appraised the participants with a power point presentation highlighting the various achievements under various developmental activities. In addition the latest action taken reports about the decisions taken during the last review meeting under the chairmanship of said Hon'ble Minister were also discussed threadbare and the implementation of decisions were appreciated by the chair. Accordingly, the following instructions/decision were taken in the review meeting.

- It was decided that measures should be worked out for imparting long duration training courses to the field functionaries of RDD besides 03 months training courses to the rural educated youth while providing training under different programmes of Rural Dev. Deptt. at RETC Budgam.
- All the ACDs / DPOs were directed for immediate issuance of advertisement notices for engagement of Data entry operator cum Accounts assistants in all districts and process for engagement of the same should be completed within one month after consulting ITI authorities of the respective districts for observance of all codal formalities/ procedures.
- Regarding black topping of Rural roads on pilot basis, it was decided that an alternate concept especially paving of interlock tiles instead of black topping of roads will be adopted as the SE

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(REW) and Xens stated that due to lack of machinery and specific skilled labour for the purpose, the same cannot be carried out properly. A committee comprising of SE (REW) Kashmir, ACD Srinagar, ACD Budgam, Xen (REW) Srinagar and Xen (REW) Budgam has been nominated at this Directorate level who will examine the matter in consultation with Mission Director SRLM and furnish their comments in order to proceed further.

- The job of registering/uploading of PMAY beneficiaries as per SECC 2011 though uploaded up to the extent of 5,224 Nos. as stated by JD(p) but the same was seriously viewed by the Hon'ble Minister and accordingly all the ACDs were directed to complete the uploading of beneficiaries list within weeks time positively. Besides, all the ACDs/BDOs will also ensure inclusions/exclusions of beneficiaries under PMAY and those who are to be got included out of SECC 2011 survey should also be expedited after observing the prescribed procedures required for the same as per standing guidelines. Moreover, it was also decided that an advertisement slide be got telecasted on TV channels during news bulletins so as to arrest the practice of touts etc. as reported from some places.
- It was also decided that a typical design for construction of PMAY dwelling units be formulated by the SE (REW) Kashmir in consultation with Xen (REW) Srinagar/Budgam and AE Technical (Mr. Noor-ud-Din) and will ensure submission of same to the Adm. Deptt. for approval/adoption on 10/7/2017 (Monday).
- Tournaments with regard to sports activities was also discussed and accordingly it was decided that the same should be started in all the Districts by the concerned ACDs/DPOs wherein HODs of Rural Dev. Deptt. be invited for their participation for which the advertisement should also come in press releases for its wide publicity.
- Regarding the issue of Installation of Hoardings at various District/Block Headquarters the Hon'ble Minister was apprised that the authorised agency has not executed the work as per the approved specifications and instead has requested to approve the revised specifications which generally required for installation of these hoardings and the installation of same has



- been made on these specification in Jammu Province as well. The Hon'ble Minister was also apprised that the matter has already been taken up with Adm. Deptt. for allowing the instant case including the IEC Plan for 2017-18 before the Divisional level Purchase Committee for further Consideration/decision.
- It was also decided that the anti-polythene drive started by the Rural Dev. Deptt. should be accelerated in all the Panchyats / blocks in order to curb this menace.
 - Regarding MGNREGA it was also directed that during vetting of the plan the same should not be altered at any cost and only the plan vetted by the respective Gram Sabhas should be implemented in letter and spirit after consulting the concerned Hon'ble MLA. However, in case the any Hon'ble MLA will try to delay the vetting of the plan, the ACD concerned should go ahead for implementation of the same but after observing the codal formalities like recommendation/resolution of Gram Sabha etc.
 - Regarding verification of some case assigned to Mr. Fayaz Ahmad ACD Budgam, he was also directed to furnish his report within fortnight including the report regarding spun pipes procured in Shopian District during 2012-13 in excess /in anticipation of the requirement.
 - ACDs/Xens (REW) were directed to furnish their requisitions of required key construction material for procurement to divisional level purchase committee and no key construction material shall be procured locally. Hon'ble Minister viewed seriously the low performance on account of completion rate of MGNREGA works and directed all the ACDs to accelerate the job of the work completion rate on MIS.
 - It was also observed that only 06 districts except Districts Ganderbal, Bandipora, Kulgam, Shopian, Kargil and Leh have furnished the utilization certificates under MGNREGA, accordingly the defaulting districts were directed to expedite the submission of UCs by or before 10th instant.
 - It was decided that video conferencing facility in each District should be provided for which the Adm. Deptt. was advised to

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expedite the process for arrangement of said facility including Directorate of RDD Kashmir, Mission Directorate SRLM, Director of Rural Sanitation etc. within a short span of time.

- Geo-tagging of SBM was also discussed and it was desired that the same should be expedited within shortest span of time.
- It was also decided that for making blocks ODF, the concerned DPOs who will show their performance will be awarded.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.
